Animal slaughter is the killing of animals, usually referring to killing domestic livestock. It is estimated that each year 77 billion land animals are slaughtered for food. In general, the animals would be killed for food; however, they might also be slaughtered for other reasons such as being diseased and unsuitable for consumption. Humane Methods of Slaughter Act Originally passed in 1958, the law that is enforced today by the USDA Food Safety and Inspection Service (FSIS) was passed as the Humane Slaughter Act of 1978. This Act requires the proper treatment and humane handling of all food animals slaughtered in USDA inspected slaughter plants.

A slaughterhouse, also called abattoir (/ˈæbətɑːtɔːr/ (listen)), is a facility where animals are slaughtered, most often (though not always) to provide food for humans. Slaughterhouses supply meat, which then becomes the responsibility of a packaging facility.

Killing of slaughter animals is usually done by exsanguination (bleeding). An incision (sticking) which severs the major arteries of the neck or anterior thoracic cavity causes a rapid loss of blood, resulting in a lack of oxygen to the brain. Irreversible cellular changes occur and the animal dies.

To minimize distress to animals and to prevent human injury during slaughter, methods and agents should be selected that maintain calm animals. Attention to species-specific anatomy, physiology, natural history, husbandry, and behavior will assist in understanding how various methods and agents may impact an animal during slaughter.

Unlike animals raised for food, the vast majority of horses sent to slaughter will have ingested, or been treated or injected with, multiple chemical substances that are known to be dangerous to humans, untested on humans or specifically prohibited for use in animals raised for human consumption.
