Does New York Have an Inheritance Tax or Estate Tax? While New York doesn't charge an inheritance tax, it does include an estate tax in its laws. The state has set a \$5.25 million estate tax exemption, meaning if the decedent's estate exceeds that amount, the estate is required to file a New York estate tax return.

### Inheritance Tax - Paradigm Wills

Since April 2010, each person has a tax free inheritance tax allowance of £325,000. If the Estate is over £325,000 Inheritance Tax can be payable. HMRC has reported that only 4-5% of Estates actually pay Inheritance Tax, and the tax is paid by the Estate and not by the beneficiaries named in the Will.

The estate may not have to pay this tax. If the money and property etc is to go to the deceased's partner or spouse, then there will be no inheritance tax. Back to Wills and Probate. Again, Wills do NOT avoid probate. The four quickest ways to avoid probate is-Gifts. You can gift up to \$14,000 per year per person for the 2015 tax year. You can gift more, but you eat into your lifetime exclusion which is the federal inheritance tax limit of \$5.43 million for the 2015 tax year.
